VISION AND MISSION

Saint Mary's School, Bhikkawala was established in 1991 and is being run by the Catholic Diocese of Bijnor, Kotdwar, Garhwal. It is a Co-educational institution. The Bishop of Bijnor, is the President of this prestigious institution. The aim of the St. Mary's School is to form 'New Persons' who promote universal and long-lasting values and building them fully alive to bring about a just society. It believes that education in the correct sense is something more than textbooks, examinations and degrees. St. Mary's School strives to cultivate in children self confidence, the spirit of adventure and sportsmanship to build up the student's aptitude to think, write and speak efficiently and communicate themselves innovatively. It instills in students an understanding and admiration of our cultural heritage and imbues aesthetic feeling, a sense of accountability and reverence for social and moral values through multifarious activities. St. Mary's School is well known for its excellence in discipline, quality education, training of body and mind as well as moral education. St. Mary's School venture to outline persons who are intellectually competent, morally sound, psychologically integrated with the sense of the Divine, committed to the cause of justice peace and constantly opened to uphold growth. St. Mary's School has withstood the test of time and each student is the pillar of this institution. We long to construct a human society, free from prejudices, superstitions and discrimination based on sex, religion, caste and economic status.

Motto

St. Mary's School, Bhikkawala holds out the Motto; "Devotion, Service, Knowledge" in all curricular, co-curricular ac-

tivities. The significant motto inspires the staff and students to foresee and plan, to inculcate self-confidence to bring out brilliance so as to achieve their goals by committing fully to the entrusted responsibilities.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The School Promotes the idea of ‘भक्ति, सेवा, ज्ञान’ means Devotion, Service, Knowledge. It aims at providing quality education to Catholic students but it is also open to all the students irrespective of caste and creed. Spirit of patriotism, religious tolerance, communal harmony, concern for the poor are fostered through different programs. The school aims at high academic excellence and good discipline through infusion of spiritual and moral values.

SPECIAL FEATURES OF SAINT

MARY'S SCHOOL

1. The medium of instruction is English and Hindi.
2. The learning of Moral Science remains obligatory for all students since the formation of a sound character is the true test of worthy education.
3. The school will insist on strict discipline of the students especially in punctuality, mutual respect, regular school attendance, cleanliness, hard work and fidelity to students.

ADMISSIONS

- ❖ Kids are admitted to the School Nursery at the age of Three, with a corresponding increase of age for the higher classes. Original Birth Certificate of the candidate issued by the civil authorities should be produced at the time of admission.

Parents should take utmost care to fill correct name and surname of their ward as these will not be changed in future.

- ❖ No admission is given to LKG and higher classes until the Transfer Certificate (TC) from the previous school is produced.

WITHDRAWALS AND LEAVE

- ❖ Application for T.C. has to be given in writing to the Principal by the parent/guardian along with the prescribed fee of Rs. 100/-. At least 02 working days are needed to process the Transfer Certificate. T.C. will be issued only after all dues to the School have been paid in full.
 - ◆ If a student is migrating to another district/state for further studies the T.C. has to be counter-signed by the (Bijnor) District Education Officer (DEO). The Parents will have to pay the expenses involved in this transaction.
- ❖ Application for *leave* should be made to the Principal, well in advance stating the reason, number of days and signature of the parent/ guardian.
- ❖ Pupils suffering from contagious or infectious diseases are not allowed to attend the school. When they report back to school, they must produce a certificate of medical fitness.
- ❖ If a student is absent without *leave* application for 10 or more days, her/his name will be struck off from the rolls. Re-admission, if granted will be done as per the rules of admission.
- ❖ No pupil will be sent home during class hours.

GENERAL RULES

- 1 Be polite and gentlemanly in and outside the school.
- 2 Be honest and truthful in all matters.
- 3 Accept cheerfully whatever responsibility is given, and face difficulties with courage and determination.

- 4 Be courteous to the officials in the playground and take part in games with good sportsman-spirit.
- 5 Greet your parents, teachers and elders whenever you meet them.
- 6 Have proper care of hair at all times, avoid long nails, colouring nails and other modern fashion styles. Boys shall avoid long hair and fashionable hair style.
- 7 Respect your school property, as well as those that belong to others.
- 8 Be punctual and regular in coming to school.
- 9 Be bold to say 'No' when asked to do something that is basically wrong.
- 10 Strict regularity, implicit obedience, courtesy in speech and conduct, cleanliness of dress and person, are expected from every pupil. The students must strictly conform to the regulations laid down in this regard.
- 11 The students are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct not only in the school, but also outside. Any objectionable conduct outside the school makes them liable for disciplinary action, because such conduct would endanger the good name of the school.
- 12 No collection of money is to be made without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 13 Gifts to the members of the staff, or other expressions in their honour, are not allowed, without the permission of the Principal.
- 14 All students must possess a copy of the school handbook.
- 15 Students must participate in the daily assembly.
- 16 The students are not allowed to visit the staff rooms without the permission of the teachers.
- 17 Fines may be imposed by the Principal or the staff for irregularity, indiscipline, damage to the school property, improper uniform, etc.

- 18 On National Days - Republic Day, Independence Day and Gandhi Jayanti - every student must be present for the school activities. Absence on these days will be considered very grave and anti-nationalistic, and hence, appropriate action will be taken.
- 19 Lost and found articles are to be deposited in the office.
- 20 The Principal may punish a student in a manner suited to the seriousness or frequency of the offence, which may vary from detention after school hours to suspension, or even expulsion from the Institution.
- 21 The Principal reserves the right to waive aside any of the rules contained in the hand book.
- 22 The interpretations of any rule in the hand book rests solely and entirely with the Local Managing Body of this school. Their interpretations and decisions are final.
- 23 For any grave disobedience to the clearly expressed orders of the Principal, punishment laid down is dismissal without any warning. The same applies to moral turpitude, defacing of the School property and premises, and defiance of the authorities and teachers.
- 24 Students are not excused from games and physical activities without a written note from a qualified doctor.
- 25 Do not bring and throw colours on any person within the school premises during the season of Holi; the same applies to the crackers and bursting them in the campus. Anyone indulging in these will be severely dealt with.
- 26 Any student asked to leave from the school on disciplinary grounds shall have the same mentioned in his/her Transfer Certificate.
- 27 **Students are strictly forbidden to bring motorized vehicles, four/two wheelers to the school.**
- 28 The School Gate will not be opened for any Parent/Guardian at any cost during recess.

- 29 Every student is issued a School Handbook at the beginning of the Academic Session. Students are required to complete both-the Personal Memo in the handbook and the medical Record and submitted to the school office. The handbook meant for students to record their activities in school. It is also an important means of communication between the school and the parents with regard to the progress and conduct of each child. Students are expected to bring their hand book to school every day and parents are requested to check the handbook every day.
- 30 Both the School Hand Book and Identity card are issued to the students at the beginning of the Academic Session. It is compulsory for all students to carry the identity card with them daily, when attending school and whenever they are representing the school outside the premises or traveling with the school party on out station picnics/tours.
31. No student shall use chewing gum, tobacco in any form like pan masala in the vicinity of the school.

TIPS FOR STUDENTS

- ❖ All students are expected to be in the school at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time for the morning assembly.
- ❖ Punctuality is a virtue that the School Management wishes to impart to its students. Hence, late coming to the school is strictly prohibited. Late comers may be admitted into the class ONLY with the consent of the Principal.
- ❖ All should be particularly careful not to throw garbage anywhere in the school premises. They should use dustbin specially provided for the purpose.
- ❖ Smoking or use of any intoxicative article by a student is strictly prohibited inside and outside the School premises. Those found violating this rule will be dismissed with immediate effect.

- ❖ Scribbling on the walls, desks and board is strictly forbidden. Any kind of damage to be done to school property shall have to be made good by the parents/guardians of the wrongdoer.
- ❖ Any kind of damage caused to the School property must be compensated by the Parents/Guardians of the ward. The decision of the Principal regarding the compensation to be paid is final.
- ❖ Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is not allowed.
- ❖ It is compulsory for every student to have 80% of total attendance to appear for the final examination.
- ❖ All students are expected take active parts in co-curricular activities, sports etc arranged by the School.
- ❖ Absentees in an examination will be considered failed unless it is established satisfactorily that their absence was due to illness or any other serious reason.
- ❖ As a matter of discipline, students shall not wear ornaments, bracelets, bangles, rings, costly earrings, decorative hairpins and such luxurious accessories.
- ❖ Bringing of arms and weapons like knives, chains and fire arms to the School and ganging up with the students of one's own School or outsiders justify immediate dismissal.
- ❖ All students must keep their books clean, neatly covered with their name written on them.
- ❖ Irregular attendance, truancy, insubordination to the Teachers and habitual neglect of studies, indifference to School work and obscenity in word or action are sufficient reasons for the suspension of a pupil.
- ❖ Every student shall bring to the School hand book and ID Daily.
- ❖ Student are strictly forbidden to use motor vehicles to the School. If a student found using motor vehicles in School uniform he/she must be prevented to attend the School and disciplinary actions will be taken against them.

- ❖ Students shall not bring cell phones and similar electronic gadgets to the School and if student found violating this rule, the gadgets confiscated and will not be returned during the academic year.
- ❖ If students defame the School Management, staff, colleagues, supporting staff members etc. through the SOCIAL MEDIA he/she will be taken to task and they will have face the legal consequences.
- ❖ Students should be docile, clean, neat and hard working. The school authorities do not accept any responsibility for the loss of books, clothes, money, tiffin carrier etc.
- ❖ If a police complaint/FIR filed against any student he/she will be dismissed with immediate effect.
- ❖ Physical training, sports, co-curricular activities and School cleaning duties are compulsory subjects of the School. If a student is physically unfit for these activities, a doctor's certificate should be submitted to the Principal and must obtain special permission from the Principal.
- ❖ *Since English language has become the universal language of communication, the School administration has made efforts to improve English language skills of its students. In order to improve the confidence of the students in speaking English they are advised to speak only English in the School premises.*

DIRECTIVES TO THE PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- ❖ Parents/Guardians are expected to co-operate with the School authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline, helping their child to prepare their lessons and taking active interest in the activities of the school.
- ❖ Parents are expected to take note of the reports card and messages conveyed to them through the Hand Book.

- ❖ If a Parent/Guardian has a genuine complaint against the School Management, it should be made in writing and submitted to the Principal. The Management will certainly act upon the complaints submitted to it.
- ❖ **Parents/Guardians are NOT ALLOWED to walk into the class rooms or to the staff rooms during School hours.**
- ❖ No one should approach the Principal for promotion of a student who has failed to get promotion in the exams.
- ❖ Parents should provide their children with the necessary books and stationery as per the time table.
- ❖ In case of an emergency to contact the Parents/Guardians, the School Management requires the correct address and telephone of the Parents/Guardians. Therefore, they are requested to report any changes in the home address or the telephone numbers to the School office in writing.

NORMS OF PROMOTION

- ❖ Promotion is granted on the basis of the whole year's work of the students.
- ❖ **No examination will be taken either before or after the scheduled time.**
- ❖ Student who failed twice in the same class and three times in different classes will be asked to leave the School.
- ❖ Students who do not have 80% attendance at the end of the session, will be prevented from appearing from the Annual Examination.
- ❖ 33% is the standard passing marks in each subject for promotion.
- ❖ Medical certificate must be produced in case of serious illness.
- ❖ Results will be declared at the end of the year; in all cases it will not be reconsidered.

CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

At the end of the academic session, certificates of merit are awarded in each class, to acknowledge the talents and outstanding contributions of individual students. The certificates are awarded in the following categories.

1. Student of the year
2. Excellence in studies
3. Co-curricular activities
4. 100% Attendance

PRIVATE TUITIONS

1. Students should not be forced to study for longer periods. Private Tuition is absolutely FORBIDDEN without prior discussion with the Principal. Private Tuitions can be engaged in exceptional cases, where a child has missed classes due to prolonged illness or is a slow learner.
2. Tuition is injurious to genuine progress of the student. He/she is not encouraged to learn self skills and is prone to being inattentive, distracted and undisciplined in class.
3. If Teachers of Saint Mary's Bhikkawala engage students of the School in private tuitions without prior written permission from the Principal, then disciplinary action will be taken against those teachers.

MEDICAL GUIDANCE

1. Students suffering from diseases such as Chicken Pox, Cholera, Measles, Mumps, Whooping-Cough and Jaundice must observe the prescribed period quarantine.
2. Students suffering from infectious diseases like conjunctivitis, Dermation Scabies etc., should not be sent to school until they are clear of the infection.
3. Students suffering from chronic diseases like Asthma, Epilepsy, Rheumatic heart disease etc., are advised to be under continual Medical Supervision of a Specialist Doctor. History of their illness must be filled up in the Diary along with the treatment being taken. They should inform the school Authorities as well.

4. Parents are required to fill up the Medical Card given in the Hand Book.

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

1. The student's dress and grooming should reflect high Standards of personal conduct. His/her attire should promote a safe and a positive atmosphere within the school. For this the students and their Parents/ Guardians have the responsibility to be aware of the school's specific dress code and conform to those requirements.
2. The following will be considered inappropriate:
 - i) Accessories such as gold/silver chains, rings, ear rings and any other form of jewellery.
 - ii) Applying henna, gel, streaking or colouring of hair, long nails, nail polish and tattoos.
3. Besides the School uniform, decency and good taste demands that the students compulsory wear vests and undergarments in the School.
4. **Specifications related to hair:**
 - i) Boys must have close cropped hair.
 - ii) Girls who have their hair cut very short have to wear a white stretch band.
 - iii) Hair till the nape of the neck must be secured away from the face with a white stretch band.
 - iv) Parents will be contacted about their child if the school administration feels the dress code is violated or if the Student's appearance and creates indiscipline or is a safety hazard.

CONVEYANCE

The School Management does not take the responsibility of CONVEYANCE of its students. It is the duty of the Parents/ Guardians to reach the students to the School and to fetch them from the School.

INSTRUCTIONS OF FEES

1. The School fee can be deposited either in the State Bank of India, Kalagarh or in cash at the School Office in the prescribed dates. (From 1st to 15th of every month)
2. The Fee is categorized under the following heads
 - (a) Admission Fee (b) Examination Fee
 - (c) Composite Fee.
3. Composite fee consists of tuition fee, annual fee, annual day fee, staff welfare fund, Audio Visual, Celebrations & Functions, Electricity, Furniture, water, sports and games, teaching aids, medical, library etc.
4. Parents have the option to deposit fee for the whole year together in advance in the bank if they find it convenient.
5. Duplicate fee booklet can be issued by the school on payment of Rs.50/-.
6. Parents are requested to keep the receipts issued to them and produce them as proof of fee deposited.
7. School fee will be charged for twelve months irrespective of late admission or early leaving.
8. No deductions are made in the fee for vacations or broken periods.
9. The fee is charged throughout the year and it has to be paid as long as the student's name is on roll.
10. Fee once remitted is not refundable.
11. Students who fees not remitted all fee dues will not be permitted to appear for examinations.
12. Fine of Rs. 10.00 (Rupees Ten) per day will levied on upon those students who fail to deposit the school fee by the 15th each month. Rs. 100.00 (Rupees Thundred) per month will be added in subsequent months.
